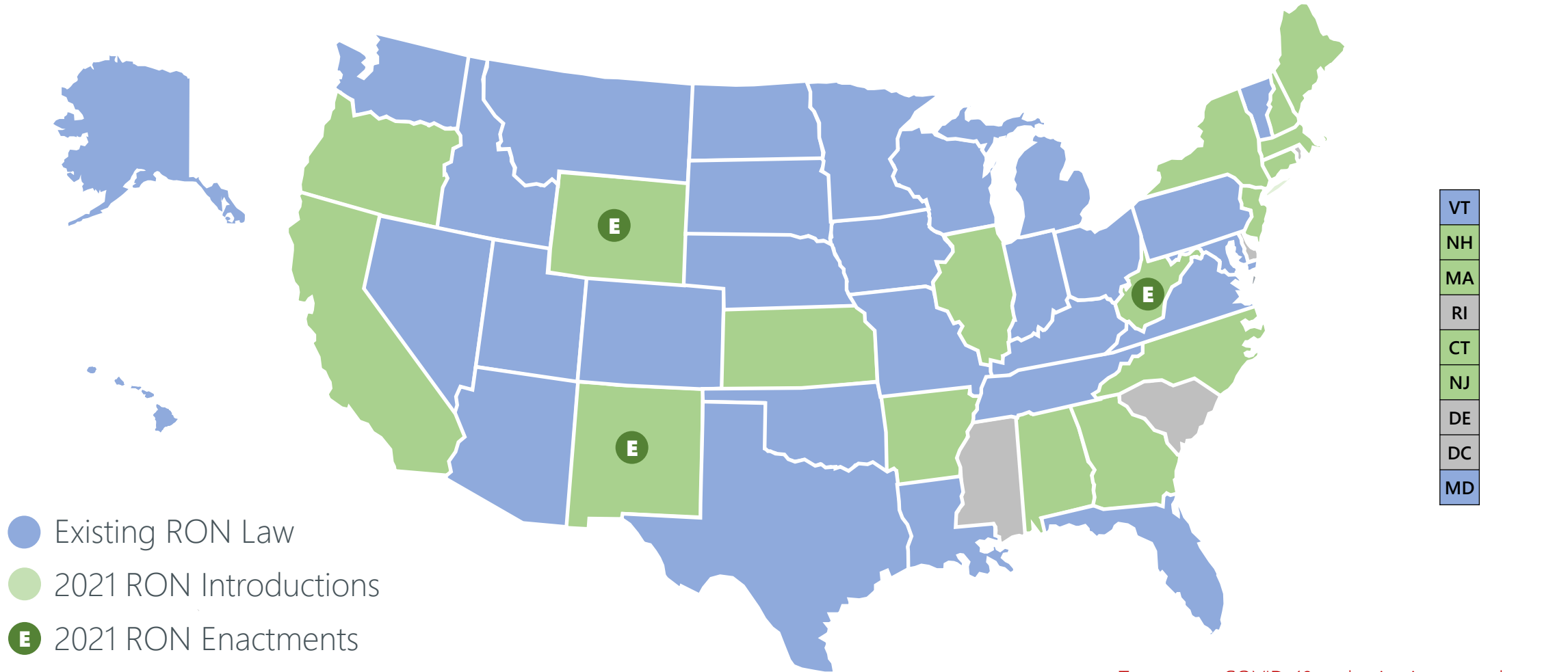

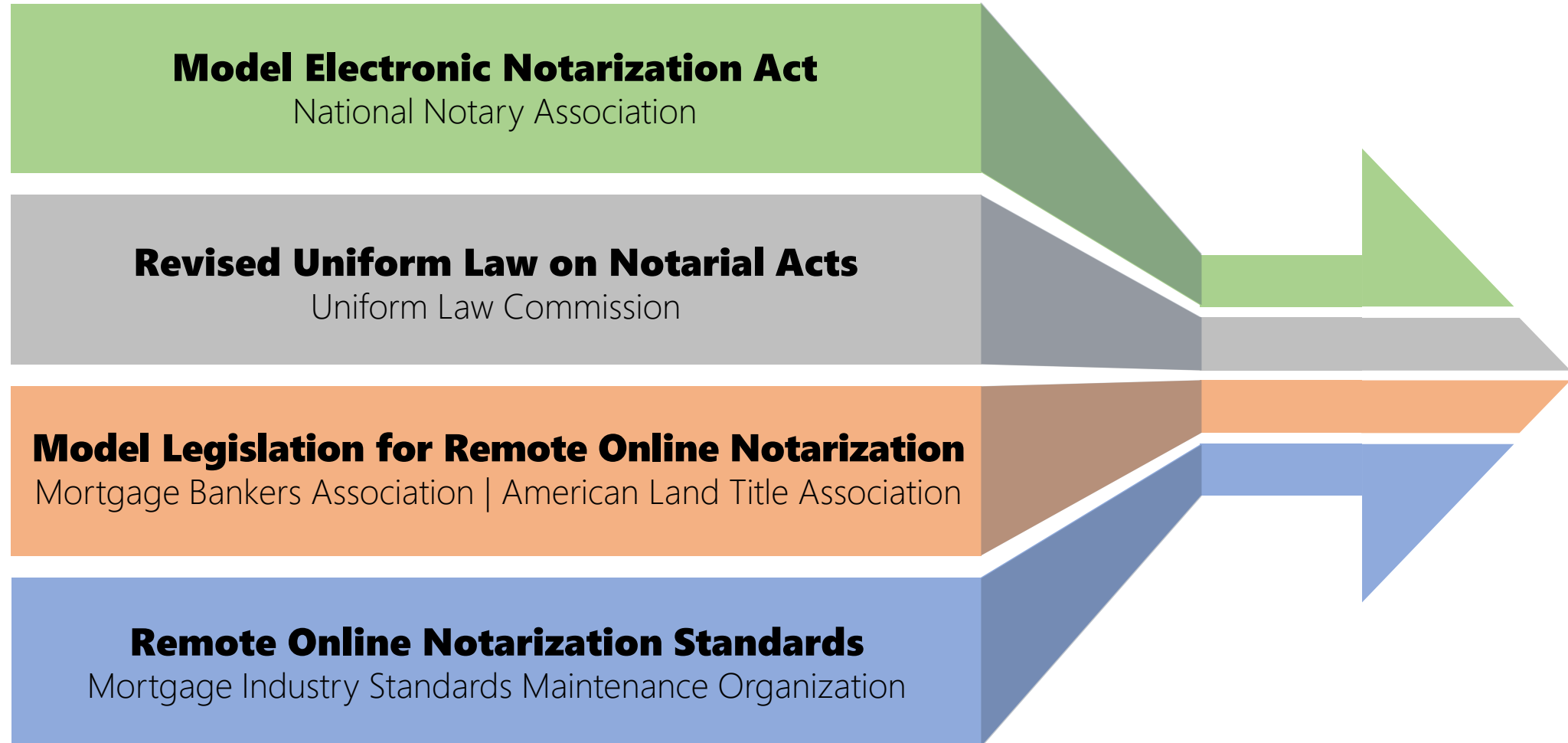

Key Policies to Consider



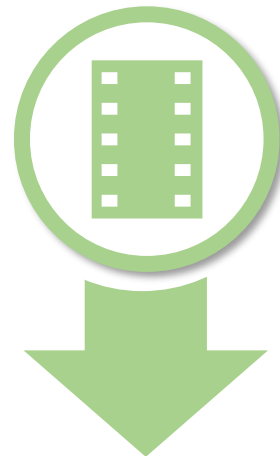
Identification

Multiple factors (something you *know*, *have* and *are*) are used to identify the remotely located individual



Electronic Records

The electronic record is presented to the remotely located individual and Notary at the same time and is "tamper-sealed"



A/V Recording

Evidence of the remotely located individual's competence and willingness to sign, and the Notary's actions is saved



Recognition

Existing state recognition statutes are leveraged to facilitate the acceptance of RONs across state borders
