


Figure 1. Number of Cases with Verdicts over \$1 Million

Medical Malpractice Jury Trial Verdicts (2019)

"Social inflation" – difficult to define

- The term "Social Inflation" doesn't even have an agreed upon, specific definition
 - Casualty Actuarial Society Research Paper: "there's no universally agreed-upon definition of social inflation." (CAS goes on to detail 12 different recent definitions of "social inflation" in published papers 2010-21.)
 - The Geneva Association: "Social inflation is a term that is widely cited in insurance debates, but it is often ill-defined or at best only loosely explained."
 - InsuranceThoughtLeadership.com: "as an industry, we are struggling to define it"
- Whatever "Social Inflation" is, it is hard to measure; see, for example :
 - Triple-I CEO: "...a concept that's hard to measure..."
 - Gen Re article: "...hard to find empirical evidence that supports or disproves it."

A study by Profs. Samuel Antill (Harvard Business School, Finance) and Stephen Grenadier (William F, Sharpe Chair of Financial Economics, Stanford Graduate School of Business) found not only that "litigation financing does not lead to the filing of risky frivolous lawsuits," but also that "litigation financing deters defendants from engaging in wasteful bullying strategies" (Samuel Antill and Stephen R. Grenadier, *Financing the Litigation* Arms Race at 29, https://papers.ssrn.com/sol3/papers.cfm?abstract_id=3719238

(June 5, 2022)).
