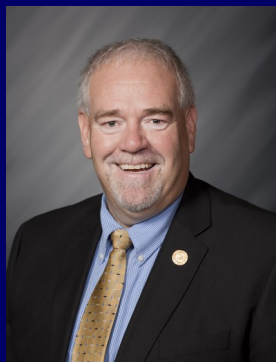

## Reminder that Contributing States are Eligible for Two Legislator Stipends per National Meeting to Help Underwrite the Cost of Participating.

In many states, legislators' travel expenses are extremely limited or are paid entirely out-of-pocket. The stipend program works in part with the new state dues structure by allocating funds for states to send two legislators (one per chamber) per meeting, in an effort to help underwrite the cost of participating. Stipends cover the NCOIL registration fee, as well as reasonable travel and meal expenses up to \$1,000
