#### **Definition of ESG**

ESG: Environmental, Social, and Governance

A lack of consensus when it comes to

- Risk management practice
- Opportunities that create long-term value
- Social values good business & economics

etc.

#### E in ESG

- 1. Examples of environmental factors: Climate change, GHG, waste, pollution, etc.
- 2. Top 3 risks (World Economic Forum, 2019)
- Extreme weather events
- Failure of climate-change mitigation and adaptation
- Natural disasters

### S in ESG

1. Covers a company's relations with its workforce, customers, and society.

2. Examples of social factors: Human rights, diversity, workforce, community relations, etc.

## **G** in ESG

1. The system by which a firm is governed and controlled.

2. Examples of governance factors: board structure, executive pay, SH rights, etc.

## **History of Modern ESG**


#### 1. Origin

The UN (Kofi Anan, Secretary-General) 2004 report titled "Who Cares Wins" coined the term ESG

- 2. US Business Roundtable's Statement on the Purpose of a Corporation (Aug 2019)
- "commit to lead their companies for the benefits of *all* stakeholders—customers, employees, suppliers, communities and shareholders."
- → Shift from shareholder capitalism to stakeholder capitalism

#### **ESG Investing Strategies:**


- Negative screening / Exclusion / Divestment

- Thematic investing


### **ESG & Financial Performance**

- + 2,200 Studies







### **ESG & Financial Performance**
