


BARRIERS TO A PATIENT-CENTERED

IDEAL MODEL OF CARE

- In 2023 the Arthritis Foundation formally launched a multiyear project called **Ideal Model of Care** with the goal of addressing barriers patients face in achieving their optimal health care.
 - 3,500+ survey responses from patients, focus groups, expert interviews to better understand challenges
 - Prior authorization was reported as a top barrier for patients.
- In a separate survey in 2023 on utilization management:
 - 37% of Arthritis Foundation-affiliated patients reported having to go through prior authorization every plan year for at least the previous five years.
 - While most patients waited one or two days for a response to their appeal, over 31% of patients reported having to wait over seven business days for any response from their insurer.


BARRIERS TO A PATIENT-CENTERED

IDEAL MODEL OF CARE

- As a result of an unsuccessful prior authorization appeal, most patients had to switch to another medication.
- Nearly a quarter did not use any medication for a period of time.
- About 15% paid out of pocket for their prescription, while others spread out the dosing of their medication while waiting for an appeal decision.
- For patients living with arthritis, it can take
 months or even years to find a treatment that
 works. Interruptions can result in negative health
 consequences such as progression of disease
 and patients may miss work or become
 permanently disabled as a result.

- Prioritize continuity of care for patients
- Ensure timely access & administrative efficiency
- Require transparency for appeals & exemptions
