

### **Amendment to Section 4(d)**

(d) Provide the ~~currently insured property owner~~ named insured a ~~minimum of 60 days~~ time period consistent with notice requirements of this state to cure the defects/or conditions underlying a non-renewal from the date the insurer identifies the specific conditions., ~~even if that exceeds the non-renewal notice period as set forth in [insert citation to state nonrenewal requirements].~~ An insurer shall have the right to assess the work used to correct defects to ensure they have been corrected in a manner that meets the standards originally communicated by the insurer in subsection (a).

*Drafting Note: States are encouraged to amend their non-renewal notice laws to ensure that the non-renewal notice period is at least 60 days.*
